### Band Biography

The J.C. Band has been one of the top performing cover acts at Festivals and Nightclubs throughout Southern Wisconsin for over twenty years. The band's primary musical style consists of classic top 40 dance rock from the 70's to current radio hits. This includes a perpetual plethora of guest stars, a variety of lead and harmony vocals, a consideration for all requests and an outstanding repertoire of stage antics and presence. All this has contributed to packing venues and Festivals for years and continues to this day.

J.C.'s performance credits include some of the top Festivals in Southern Wisconsin including the famous J.C. Beer Tent Tour, The Crazy Legs Run, Summerfest, Warner Park's 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration, and numerous other County Fairs and local Festivals. J.C. owns one of the largest and most modern P.A. sound systems in Wisconsin, and quite possibly the entire Mid-West. Of course, the size of the venue or event dictates the equipment quantity provided. The entire P.A. set-up consists of over 40,000 watts of pure power, and complimented by top quality processing equipment and mixing boards. J.C. also owns over 100 lighting pars and special effects that also contribute to a powerful visual performance. J.C.'s sound tech. is known as one of the best in the business and is a proud part of the J.C. Band.

## Festival Pricing Reference

### Prices (The price is right!!)

Because Festivals/Fairs are so varied with their budgets J.C. has kept his price affordable while providing the best in equipment and entertainment. J.C. understands the necessity of providing you with as much general price reference detail as possible in order for the committee/chairperson to efficiently and effectively address your Festival's band budget. The following is our attempt at simplifying the process for you by breaking down the charges into separate specific expenses. The prices below are general in nature and apply specifically to small local beer tent Festivals and Fairs. Stage/tent/electrical assumed provided by each Festival/Fair. **Please note that prices are always negotiable in order to work within your budget.** Any questions can be directed to J.C. at (608)-225-7733.

1. Basic Band Performance Pay (PA and Lights provided by Festival):  
The first one hour set is \$600.00  
Each one hour set after that, add \$75.00 per set!
2. PA Sound System, Lighting System and Techs provided by J.C.  
Add \$500.00
3. Mileage  
Band with stage gear only (guitars, guitar amps, and drums) ~ Free  
Band, stage gear, PA and/or Lights included ~ \$.50 per mile

### **Example:**

Simply put, a typical small tent festival which includes J.C. providing full PA and Lights for a full 4 hour show (with three-one hour sets, breaks and encore) would be easily calculated as below:

Bands Performance	$\$600 + \$75 + \$75 = \$ 750.00$
PA and Lights	\$ 500.00
Mileage 200 miles round trip from Madison	<u>\$ 100.00</u>
Total	\$1350.00

On the other hand, if the PA and Lights were provided by the Festival itself, the cost would be a mere \$750.00 for the J.C. Band with stage gear only. (Stage gear includes drums, guitars, and guitar amps.)
